HHS has delayed for one more year the implementation of ICD-10 code sets (CM & PCS) that replace the ICD-9 code sets, from October 1, 2014, to October 1, 2015. On that date, HIPAA electronic transaction standards will require the use of the ICD-10 code sets for claims, remittance advice, eligibility inquiries, referral authorizations, and other widely used transactions. Although the delay is intended to provide additional time to prepare for the transition, there is much to do.


